What part of Jesus' teaching in the Sermon on the Mount do you find most challenging?
In response to Jesus' teaching, what areas do you respond with works righteousness (Do better! Try harder!) and what areas do you give up
If God does not desire greater 'works', than we must trust he is good and desires to change our lives. Given your own story and the state of our world, do you believe God is Good? Can you trust him?
How does the empty tomb provide relief from the tension of God's sovereignty over all situations and the gift of human free will? What answers does it provide? What questions are left unanswered?
The cross and empty tomb demonstrate God's love for us. He entered our pain, conquered our greatest enemy, and offered us the victory. How could this change your story? How does this provide hope in your circumstances? Who has he given us to walk this road with?
