	Love Distorted (5:43; Lev 19)	Think about those closest to you. What standards have guided you about who care about, hang out with, serve or even love? Does the love and care you have for people have conditions?
	Narrowing love	
	Adding a command	Take a moment and think who you have considered an enemy. Who are they? What has made them an enemy? How have you justified feeling animosity, even hatred towards them?
>	Love Displayed (5:44)	
	Indiscriminate blessing (5:45b-47)	Describe a time you have been truly wronged? What is your first response? Now compare that to what Jesus is commanding us to do? What internal struggle does that create and how do we deal with that?
	Intended purpose (5:48)	
>	Love Extravagant (5:45a; 1 Jn 4:7-12)	As we struggle to love people as God does, how is the command & promise of 'Be perfect!' inspiring? How do we keep that focus and live as true human beings, beings as God intended?
	In attitude	
	In action	Who is God placing on your heart to love extravagantly? How do we do that? How do we overcome 'feelings' and love with a transformed attitude. What does that look like practically, in every day life?
