Discussion Questions

These questions are only a guide. Feel free to share how God has spoken to you, what areas you question &/or do not understand. Allow the Holy Spirit to guide your discussion.

If ‘it all goes back in the box’, what would you have left? Consider what your moments are investing in. What is being accumulated? Accomplished? Will it last?

What is the purpose of your relationship with Jesus? Why do you attend church, read scripture, pray? Consider the foolish ruler who tried manipulated Jesus’ authority to get more of what he wants. Can you relate? How are you tempted to do the same?

How has God blessed you abundantly. In what ways have you been thankful? In what ways has that tempted you to want more. Is what you have used to gain more or use it to serve God’s Kingdom?

Evaluate the treasures you treasure. What does it say about your heart? Are you living as an alien, a pilgrim, or are you living as a resident in this world. How are you living for the life yet to come?

What God treasures has been revealed in Jesus. What do you think that is? How are His treasures eternal? Are these the treasures you are treasuring, pursuing and accumulating in this short life? What adjustments need to be made in your daily living?

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
